

PRIVACY POLICY

Thank you for visiting the Envyus Media website (the "Website"). The Website is the Internet property of Envyus Media Corp ("Envyus," "we" or "us"). Envyus is committed to protecting the privacy of our visitors' personally identifiable information. To better protect your privacy, we provide this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy"), explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is used on our Website. You agree to this Privacy Policy, in its entirety, when you: (1) access or use the Website; (2) request to be contacted by Envyus, and/or attempt to contact Envyus, by filling out and submitting any applicable forms available on the Website; and/or (3) agree to receive the Envyus newsletter ("Newsletter"). If you do not agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not use or access the Website, fill out any forms available on the Website or agree to receive the Envyus newsletter.

WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

Personally Identifiable Information

We collect Personally Identifiable Information ("PII") from the Website when you request to be contacted by Envyus, attempt to contact Envyus, sign up for the Newsletter or otherwise choose to provide PII to us. PII is any information that can be used to identify or locate a particular person or entity. This includes, but is not limited to: personal name, company name, personal address, company address, telephone number, mobile number and/or email address. For example, you may choose to send us PII about yourself in an email or by completing an online form on our Website. We use your PII to send you the Newsletter which contains information regarding Envyus and our various products and services that may be of interest to you. Your contact information may also be used to reach you, when necessary, regarding issues concerning your use of the Website and the Newsletter. Once collected, we will store your PII for a reasonable period of time for record keeping purposes. The information that we store is sometimes deleted as space requires or in the normal course of business.

Information Sharing

As a general rule and other than the limited exceptions set forth below, Envyus will not sell, share or rent your PII to or with others. Your PII is not shared with any third parties, except: (a) where required by law, or requested by a court of competent jurisdiction; (b) in the event of Envyus bankruptcy, or if Envyus is sold or acquired; (c) where you are in violation of this Privacy Policy or the Website's Terms and Conditions; or (d) where Envyus determines, in its sole discretion, that such disclosure is necessary to protect the rights of Envyus and/or a third party, or necessary to protect Envyus from liability of any kind.

Non-Personally Identifiable Information

We may collect certain Non-Personally Identifiable Information ("Non-PII") about you when you visit many of the Website's pages, such as the type of browser you are using (e.g., Netscape, Internet Explorer), the type of operating system you are using, (e.g., Windows '98 or Mac OS) and the domain name of your Internet service provider (e.g., Comcast, Earthlink, TimeWarner, etc.).

We use the Non-PII that we collect to improve the design and content of the Website and to enable us to personalize your Internet experience. We also may use this information in the aggregate to analyze Website usage.

Cookies

To enhance your experience with the Website, we use "cookies." Cookies are used by your computer's browser to store your preferences. We use both session and persistent cookies. Cookies, by themselves, do not tell us your e-mail address or other personally identifiable information.

We use cookies to understand Website usage and to improve the content and offerings on the Website. You can disable cookies through your Internet browser. If you set your browser not to accept cookies, you will still be able to use the Website. To find out more about cookies, please visit www.cookiecentral.com.

New Technology

The use of technology on the Internet, including cookies, is rapidly developing. As a result, Envyus strongly encourages individuals to revisit this Privacy Policy for any updates regarding its use of new technology.

Links

The Website contains links to other websites for Envyus owned properties whose information practices may be different than the Website. This Privacy Policy does not cover the use of information by these websites. Visitors should consult the privacy notices of these other websites.

Third Party Links

In addition, the Website may contain links to other third-party websites ("Third Party Websites"). Please be aware that Envyus is not responsible for the privacy practices of Third Party Websites. We encourage you to be aware when you leave the Website and to read the privacy policies of each and every website that collects PII. This Privacy Policy applies solely to information collected by the Website.

No Information Collected from Children

We encourage parents and guardians to spend time online with their children and to participate and monitor the interactive activities of their children. Envyus will never knowingly collect any personal information about children under the age of eighteen (18) years old. If Envyus obtains actual knowledge that it has collected personal information about a child under the age of eighteen (18) years old, that information will be immediately deleted from its database. Because it does not collect such information, Envyus has no such information to use or to disclose to third parties. Envyus has designed this policy in order to comply with the Children's Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA").

Security

All collected information is stored in a technically and physically secure environment. We take precautions to protect PII both online and off-line. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your PII, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information that you

transmit to us, and you do so at your own risk. Once we receive your transmission, we make reasonable efforts to ensure its security on our systems. All of our users' information, not just PII, is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to PII. Furthermore, access to this information is strictly limited, and not accessible to the public. Our employees are dedicated to ensuring the security and privacy of all user information. Employees not adhering to our firm policies are subject to disciplinary action.

Please note that any attempt to breach the security of the network, our servers, databases or other hardware or software supporting the Website or other websites under the control of Envyus constitutes a crime punishable by law. We will turn over to authorities, any and all evidence relating to a potential breach of security or other abuse against the network, servers, databases or other such supporting equipment or software. In compliance with applicable federal and state laws, we shall notify you in the event that we learn of an information security breach with respect to your PII. You will be notified via e-mail in the event of such a breach. Please be advised that notice may be delayed in order to address the needs of law enforcement, determine the scope of network damage, and to engage in remedial measures.

Deleting and Updating Your Information

Your Rights under the CCPA

Under this Privacy Policy, and by law if You are a resident of California, You have the rights listed below.

The right to notice. You must be properly notified which categories of Personal Data are being collected and the purposes for which the Personal Data is being used.

The right to access / the right to request. The CCPA permits You to request and obtain from the Company information regarding the disclosure of Your Personal Data that has been collected in the past 12 months by the Company or its subsidiaries to a third-party for the third party's direct marketing purposes.

- Providing a different level or quality of goods or services to You
- Suggesting that You will receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

Exercising Your CCPA Data Protection Rights
